

## **ALL ABOUT ME INFOGRAPHIC**

Now that you have taken the time to determine your learning styles, values, skills etc. you will put all this information into a very convenient infographic using pictograph <http://piktochart.com>. You will need to create a username and password. Make sure to remember both.

Infographics are graphic visual representations of information, data or knowledge intended to present information quickly and clearly.

The infographic should be divided into three parts- as described below. Make sure to include graphics and creative fonts to make it stand out.

### **Part A- Introduction (Getting to know you)**

Include the following:

- name/age
- hobbies and interests
- favourite things (sports, music, books, movies, pets, food etc.)
- any awards or certificates
- other (something you wish to share)

### **Part B- The body (A closer look at you)**

Using the information you have learned in class you will describe yourself. Your writing should include evidence that supports your statements, it can come from the results from inventories, statements made by others, awards or accomplishments won or milestones you have reached.

Include the following:

- Goals (short and long term goals)
- Values (What are your values and how will you incorporate them into your life).
- Skills (What are you good at)
- Multiple Intelligences (what is your highest and lowest MI)
- Learning Style (what is it and how will this help with a career)
- Personality (introvert/extrovert/agreeable/conscientious/open)
- Emotional Intelligence (strengths and what needs improvement)
- Work habits (personal management- describe organization, time management, punctuality- what are you good at what could you improve)
- Essential skills (strength/weakness)
- Interpersonal Skills

### **Part C- The Conclusion (How does this work for you)**

What does all this information say about you. What type of career are you best suited for? Why is it important to be self-aware and knowledgeable about who you are? Based on this information what are you going to work towards, what can you build on, what have you benefitted from? How will this information help you in the future?
